

2012 Indiana NASP Tournament Qualifier Information

Due to the ever expanding interest in the Indiana NASP tournament, we have found it necessary to initiate a tournament qualifier system. We learned last year that splitting the competitors into separate halls was not an ideal situation. Therefore, we will be limiting the 2012 tournament to 792 competitors.

The tournament qualifier system has been designed to give each school an equal opportunity to qualify for the state tournament. Our hope is that it will also give schools who have not previously been involved in the state tournament the experience of shooting NASP archery in a competitive environment.

The following rules have been created by the Indiana NASP tournament committee. Please read them carefully. All timelines are concrete and cannot be waived, so please plan accordingly.

2012 Indiana NASP Tournament Qualifier

Time Line

- December 1 – January 28 – Register qualifier tournaments
- January 1 – February 12 – Shoot qualifier tournaments
- February 14 – Announce qualifying teams and individuals
- February 1 – February 14 – Preregister through the National NASP system for the State Tournament
- February 15 – February 29 – Open registration for the State Tournament
- March 16 – State Tournament

Qualifier Format

- ANY school that has NASP as part of their in school curriculum is eligible to participate. NASP MUST be taught sometime within the school year to meet this requirement. After school clubs affiliated with the school are welcome to participate as long as NASP is taught in the school.
- There are several formats available to shoot a qualifier.
- We recommend tournament qualifiers be shot face to face with at least one other school.
- Small, regionally held qualifiers may be hosted at a central school location.
- Your school may wish to host a qualifier and invite area schools.
- If your school is unable to shoot a face to face qualifier, you may shoot your qualifier with an approved proctor present. Proctors for these tournaments will be determined by state NASP tournament coordinator, Tim Beck, on an individual basis.

The Process

- Fill out qualifier registration form. (**Registration form will be available Monday, November 21st. on www.indiananasp.com**)
- Return form to Tim Beck tbeck@dnr.in.gov a minimum of 2 weeks before your official qualifying event.

- On the day of your tournament, you will conduct your tournament whether face to face or your school only, in the approved tournament format outlined in the 2012 rule package.
- Remember your team needs to have 16 – 24 with 5 of the opposite gender All rule stated in the 2012 tournament packet pertain to the qualifier.
- A limited amount of space will be available for individual shooters. These shooters will need to qualify in the same manner.
- Enter your archer's names on the tournament report form which will be sent to you after you register your qualifier. The form will be sent in an Excel spreadsheet.
- Enter each archer's scores.
- The report form will need to be signed by the proctor or an opposing team's coach in the case of a face to face tournament.
- E-mail the form within 3 days to Tim Beck tbeck@dnr.in.gov
- Mail original copy with the approval signature postmarked within 2 days to: **Tim Beck, P. O. Box 917, Jasper, IN 47547.**
- Delayed scores or scores submitted without authorized signature will not be eligible.

Who Qualifies

- The number of teams qualifying per division will be determined by the total amount of teams submitting scores in that division.
- A limited number of lanes will be reserved in each flight for individual shooters.
- If a team does not qualify, there may be an individual shooter(s) who does qualify.
- Your team will be given a choice of flights available when your qualification notification is sent to you. We will continue to give late flight preference to the schools traveling the furthest.
- You will be encouraged to preregister through the National system to expedite registration when open registration becomes available.
